Area Attractions:

Fishing: Set your hook into some of the finest landlocked salmon and trout fishing in the East.

Wildlife: Feel the excitement of viewing Moose, Deer, Fox, Eagles, Loons and Osprey. Moose watching is a huge thrill. We can tell you where to look.

Snowmobiling: Easy access to miles and miles of groomed snowmobile trails. There are hundreds of trails to explore.

ATV Trails: Access to 200 miles of ATV trails

Skiing: Grab your skis or snowboards choose from 126 trails from beginner to expert at prestigious Sugarloaf Mountain. Approximately 10 minutes away. We are also only about 30 minutes from Saddleback Mountain in Rangeley. Cross country skiers enjoy the peaceful retreat on groomed and tracked trails.

To reach us from Boston and points
South or West:

Take 95 north to exit 75 Auburn. Turn left and
go north on Route 4 to Farmington. Turn right
on Route 27 go north approximately 45 miles
to Stratton. Drive through town past the Route
16 intersection. The barn is a 1/2 mile on the
right. If you reach the bridge you just missed it.

From New Hampshire:

Take Route 16 north to Oquossoc. Go left
onto Route 4/16 South. Drive through
Rangeley to Route 16 north to Route 27. Go
left at the stop sign. The barn is a 1/2 mile on
the right. If you reach the bridge you just
missed it.

From Canada:

Take Route 27 south from the border at
Coburn Gore. You will pass Eustis and the Pine
Forest. You will come across Flagstaff bridge,
look on your left and you will see us. If you
reach the Route 16 intersection you missed us.
